Founded in 1910, the Garden holds over 10,000 types of plants and each year welcomes over 900,000 visitors from around the world. The 52-acre garden includes a number of "gardens within the Garden," the Steinhardt Conservatory, which houses the Bonsai Museum, three climate-themed plant pavilions, a white cast-iron and glass aquatic plant house, and an art gallery. The Brooklyn Museum, housed in a 560,000 square foot, Beaux-Arts building is one of the oldest and largest art museums in the country. It's world-renowned permanent collections range from ancient Egyptian masterpieces to contemporary art, and represent a wide range of cultures. *Bring your cell phone to hear an audio tour.*
