Itinerary

October 18: Newark – Lisbon

The bus departs Notre Dame of Mt. Carmel to Newark for the overnight flight to Lisbon.

October 19: Santarem- Fatima

Arrive in Portugal and meet your local guide. Depart for Santarem where we visit the Church of the Holy Miracle, containing the oldest recorded Eucharistic miracle. This miracle has been on continuous display since 1269 A.D. Here we celebrate Mass. Continue to Fatima this afternoon. Settle into your hotel and join the activities at Our Lady of Fatima Shrine. (D)

October 20: Fatima

This morning visit the Basilica for prayers, a beautiful Procession, and Holy Mass. These ceremonies are times of special graces and sometimes miracles. After lunch we go to Valinho's where we visit places where the Angel appeared and the Shrine where the Holy Virgin appeared. We'll see the outdoor Stations erected by the Americans and the beautiful Shrine of the Crucifixion built on the highest point by Hungarian refugees. In the afternoon see the tombs of Blessed Jacinta and Blessed Francisco, the Adoration Chapel, and the Miraculous Fountain. We continue with a visit to the cemetery and the children's homes in Aljustrel. Tonight, we join pilgrims from all over the world in the Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Fatima. (B. L. D.)

October 21: Batalha, Alcobaca, Nazare

Today we see two of Portugal's spectacular UNESCO World Heritage sites, beginning Batalha Monastery. We visit the Monastery of Alcobaca, founded by Portugal's first king in 1153. This Gothic masterpiece, once a Cistercian monastery, was one of the country's most important monasteries. Today it houses royal tombs and a magnificent cloistered garden. Mass will be celebrated. After touring this breathtaking site, we'll make our way to the beautiful beach city of Nazare where we'll have lunch and then take a funicular to see the beautiful Church of Our Lady of Nazareth and the little Memorial Chapel. Overnight in Fatima. (B.L.D.)

October 22: Bom Jesus -Braga

We make our way to the city of Braga, where we celebrate Mass at the spectacular Sanctuary of Our Lady of Sameiro, the country's second-largest shrine dedicated to the Virgin Mary. Our visit continues with the exploration of the Shrine of Good Jesus of the Mountain, a magnificent hilltop shrine surrounded by a lush forest. We explore the grounds, perhaps walking all the way up the Baroque double stairway to the top (381 feet) or taking the funicular which dates to the end of the 19th century. Time permitting, we visit the Monastery of St. Martin of Tibaes, previously a Benedictine monastery known for its magnificent Rococo style or the Sanctuary of Blessed Alexandrina in Balasar. This mystic and victim soul was beatified by Pope St John Paul II in 2004. Overnight in Braga. (B. D.)

October 23: Porto-Obidos- Estoril

After breakfast, we tour Porto and visit a port

making facility. Mass will be celebrated. Following lunch, we board our motorcoach and make our way to the medieval village of Óbidos. Founded in 208 BC, Óbidos is a very pretty hilltop town with many little shops and café's and a perfect place to buy that last minute present for someone at home. Time to explore the lovely hilltop town on our own before we continue to Estoril. Dinner and overnight Estoril. (B.D)

October 24: Lisbon

This morning we have a leisurely breakfast before departing for Lisbon. Our first stop is the beautiful Church of St Anthony of Lisbon, built atop the home of Portugal's most beloved saint, also known as St Anthony of Padua. We walk next door to Lisbon's Cathedral. Next, we see the UNESCO World Heritage site of the Monesteiro dos Jerónimos, the breathtaking site of a Hieronymite monastery. We see Lisbon's most famous and historical monuments: the Discoveries Monument, the Belém Tower and the National Shrine of Christ the King, a smaller, but no less amazing, version of the statue of Jesus in Brazil. Mass will be celebrated. Tonight we have a fun and festive farewell dinner in a local restaurant listening to the soulful Fado music and enjoying Portuguese wine. Overnight Estoril (B. Special dinner)

October 25: Return to USA

After breakfast you'll be transferred to the airport for the flight back to Newark. The bus will be waiting to bring you back to Notre Dame of Mt. Carmel's parking lot. (B)
