Depart Newark Airport for your overnight flight to Ireland. A transfer to the airport will be available. Information and cost will be provided closer to departure.

# Monday, June 8 Jaunting Car Ride, Adare & Limerick Panoramic Tour

### **Conditions**

#### **Airfare**

The group airfare cost is \$1392.00 each. Air taxes and fees are subject to increase until ticketed. An additional deposit of \$200.00 per person for the flights will be due on November 17, 2025. Final payment for air ticket will be February 17, 2026. Please advise Longs Travel if you will purchase airfare on your own with points. Airfare subject to increase if signing up after February 17th. Once payment is made (deposit and final air payment), it is non-refundable.

Transfers in Dublin are included in the cost of the flights. Transfers can be purchased if buying your own air. If purchasing your own flights, please wait until the trip is guaranteed to go.

June 3 UA23 departs Newark 7:30 pm arrives Dublin June 4 at 7:20 am. June 11 UA 316 departs Dublin 1:35 pm arrives Newark 4:20 pm *Schedule is subject to change by United Airlines*.

#### Insurance

Cancellation insurance is highly recommended and available for \$239.00 each double occupancy, and \$325.00 for single occupancy. Insurance must be purchased at time of deposit and will entitle you to a refund if you have to cancel for a covered reason. Once purchased, the premium is non-refundable.

\*\*\*Insurance will increase to cover the cost of flights once you add the deposit on November 17, 2025. The total cost of the insurance will be \$415.00.

Airfare is covered by insurance only if flights are purchased from CIE Tours.
