Follow the path of Peter the Great from Moscow to St. Petersburg and discover the heart of Russia

The Volga River, Europe's largest and longest waterway, holds a special place in Russian history and in the hearts and minds of the Russian people. An important aquatic "highway" since Medieval times, the Volga has long served as a major route of trade, settlement and conquest. Peter the Great sailed along the Volga from Moscow to St. Petersburg approximately 300 years ago on a quest to bring Russia out of the Dark Ages. And centuries worth of Russian music and literature reflect the people's deep feeling for the river.

Now it's your turn to discover the rich history and traditions along the imperial waterways of Russia. Your journey starts in Moscow, where you'll stand in awe of world-famous sights such as Red Square; the Kremlin; and the iconic, onion-domed St. Basil's Cathedral. Cruise along the Golden Ring to some of Russia's most beautiful cities - including Uglich and Yaroslavl, which are known for their white stone churches and gorgeous monasteries. Your journey ends in enchanting St. Petersburg, Peter the Great's "Window on the West."

Elegant architectural styles of all epochs such as Catherine's Palace and the Hermitage Museum will bring you up close to the rich traditions and royal history of Russia. Of course, no trip to Russia is complete without an enchanting evening at the Russian Ballet.

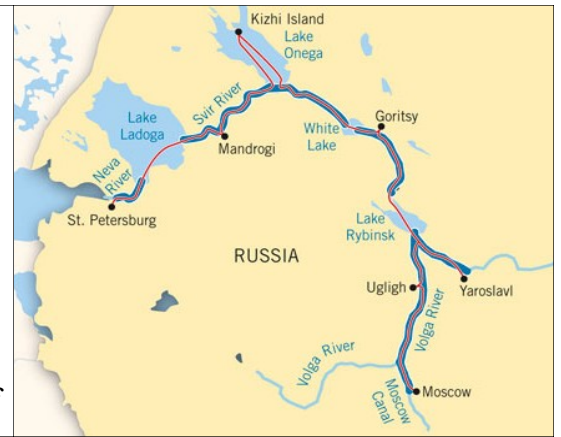

Itinerary

Sept. 14 Depart

A transfer to the airport from Cedar Knolls is included. Your overnight flight departs. Details will be forthcoming.

Sept. 15 Moscow

Arrive at the Moscow airport and transfer to the ship. Relax in your comfortable cabin before dinner. (D)

Sept. 16 Moscow *Featured Excursion:* Moscow city tour

Your panoramic city tour includes the most remarkable city sights, such as Red Square, St. Basil's Cathedral, Novodevichy (New Maiden) Convent, and impressive Tverskaya Street. (BB, L, Captain's Welcome Gala)

Sept. 17 Moscow *Featured Excursions:* Kremlin with Armory Museum

Visit the Kremlin—a self-contained 15th-century city with palaces, armories, 15th- and 17th-century cathedrals, and a Medieval fortress. You'll also explore the Kremlin's Armory Museum—home of treasures from the Czar's coronation robes to the famous Fabergé Eggs. Enjoy an afternoon at leisure with shuttle bus service provided between the ship and city center. (BB, L, D)

Sept. 18 Moscow

Enjoy an entire day at leisure. Return to the sights that caught your eye on your panoramic tour. Shuttle bus service will be provided between the ship and the city center. (BB, L, D)

Sept. 19 Cruising the Moscow Canal and Volga River

Featured Excursion: Uglich with Church of St. Dimitry on the Blood

Cruise the Moscow Canal before arriving in Uglich, a delightful Golden Ring city. Visit the Church of St. Dimitry, built to honor the slain son of Ivan the Terrible, and spend some free time browsing the local market area, replete with small shops and the stalls of local artisans. (BB, L, D)

Sept. 20 Cruising Lake Rybinsk *Featured Excursions:* Yaroslavl, heart of the Golden Ring

Yaroslavl is considered one of Russia's most beautiful cities. You'll visit the town's exquisite Church of Elijah the Prophet and delight in a tasting of local produce at the farmers' market. (BB, L, D)

Sept. 21 Goritsy *Featured Excursion:* Experience Russian daily life

Experience how locals live as you learn how traditions and handicraft techniques are preserved during a visit to the Children's House of Arts and Crafts. Take in a wood construction workshop, and then stroll the grounds of 14th-century St. Cyrill of the White Lake Monastery. (BB, L, D)

Sept. 22 Cruising Lake Onega

Featured Excursion: Kizhi Open Air Museum with 18th-century Transfiguration Church

Sail on Lake Onega to Kizhi Island, whose famous Open Air Museum is a UNESCO World Heritage Site containing the awe-inspiring Transfiguration Church, which is built entirely from wood. (BB, L, D)

Sept. 23 Cruising the Svir River, Mandrogi

Featured Excursion: Mandrogi village walking tour with *shashlik* picnic lunch ashore

Visit the reconstructed 18th-century village of Mandrogi, which brings Russia's past vibrantly to life. Peek inside its wooden houses to observe craftsmen making *matryoshkas*, lace, and ceramics. Cap the afternoon off with a traditional *shashlik* picnic. (BB, L, D)

Sept. 24 St. Petersburg

Featured Excursions: St. Petersburg panoramic city tour and evening ballet at the Alexandrinsky Theatre

Enjoy a panoramic city tour of enchanting St. Petersburg, taking in all of the majestic sights, such as Nevsky Prospect, Palace Square and Winter Palace, the Church of the Resurrection, St. Issac's, and so much more. During the evening, be treated to a spectacular Russian ballet at the Alexandrinsky Theater. (BB, L, D)

Sept. 25 St. Petersburg

Featured Excursion: Hermitage Museum in the Winter Palace

Be amazed as you tour the world-famous Hermitage Museum, which is housed in one of the world's largest palaces. The museum contains over a thousand rooms and features nearly three million works of art by masters including Leonardo da Vinci and Michelangelo. (BB, L, Captain's Farewell Dinner)

Sept. 26 St. Petersburg

Featured Excursion: Catherine Palace and Park in Pushkin

Travel to nearby Pushkin to visit lavish Catherine Palace and Park, a masterpiece of Russian Rococo architecture unrivaled in luxury and scale. (BB, L, D)

Sept. 27 Depart St. Petersburg

Disembark the ship and transfer to St. Petersburg's Pulkovo Airport for your flight home. A transfer from Newark Airport to Cedar Knolls is included. (CB/BB)

A visa for Russia is required. Visa fee is not included.



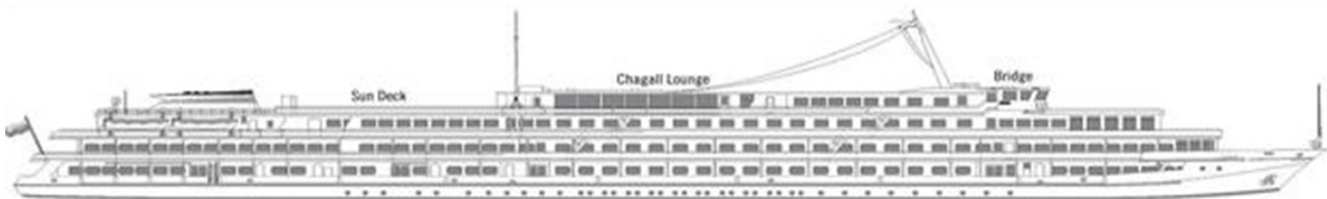

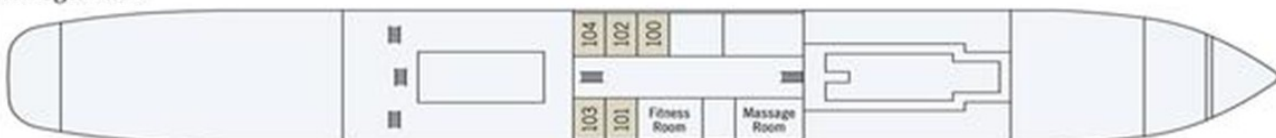
